FEATURE PROJECT

Solar Farm - Soto Cano Air Base, Honduras

HCS Group was the Prime A/E under a multidiscipline design task order providing the full design services for the planning, charrette, topographical services, and geotechnical soil evaluations with follow up design services for this project. The Project included installing the first complete renewable solar energy farm at IMCOM Soto Cano Air Base, Honduras.

A complete solar farm package was designed including solar modules, solar arrays, combiner cabinets, inverters, and power system distribution interconnection. The system was designed to carry the load of three of the Headquarters Buildings located in Headquarters Row.

The system is designed for grid connected parallel operation and offsets the power utility source demand and reduces the carbon footprint of the base.



On the heels of the Solar Farm, HCS Group has also completed the design stage of a wind/solar hybrid system on an ocean platform near Cayos Miskitos, Nicaragua in support of the host nation marine's ocean Forward Operating Location (FOL). More to follow!
