Upgrade Hospital Substation, Emergency Power Supply Switchgear and Mechanical Systems David Grant Medical Center, Travis AFB, CA

Travis Air Force Base is under the operational control of the Air Mobility Command and is located in Solano County, California. It is home to the 60th Air Mobility Wing.

Davis Grant Medical Center is the largest Air Force medical facility on the west coast and serves 96,000 active duty and retired veterans.

The Hospital Energy Plant experienced a total blackout and HCS Group was tasked to determine the root cause, develop a solution, and oversee the total design, engineering, Title II CM, Commissioning, and full inspection services for an electrical upgrade project at the Main Central Energy Plant and EES Substations facility wide. The project consisted of Facility Condition Assessments made by our in-house Technical Services personnel, evaluation and analysis of the total Medical Facility power, load, and HVAC requirements. The project design included substation and emergency power system upgrades, AHU, and HVAC systems. Construction Cost: \$24,000,000
