With the Plan Colombia helicopter program, came numerous support facilities, heliports, control towers and the latest project just completed construction, the Logistics Support Center and Warehouse located in Tolemaida. HCS Group was the Prime A/E for a facility that consisted of administration, helicopter parts warehousing with automated systems and fire protection.

Total Construction Cost: \$20,000,000

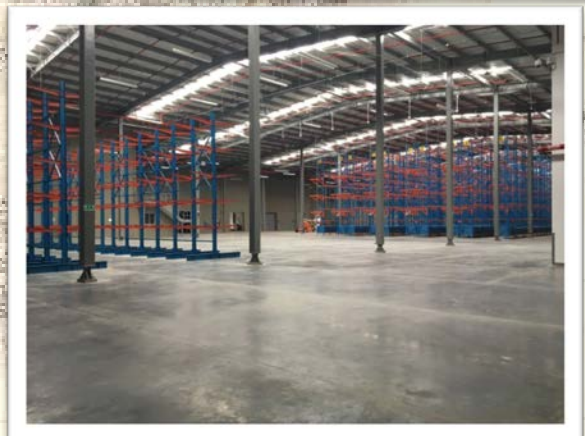
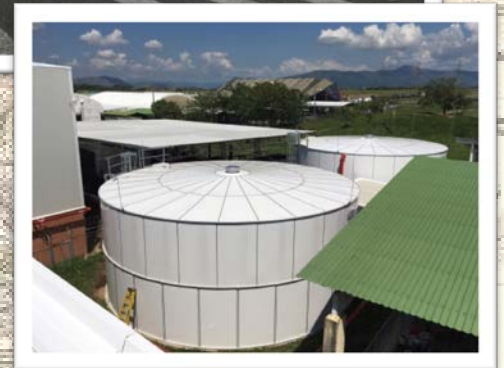
