Rural Health Clinic (H.A.P.)
El Salto - Chucunaque, Panama

HCS Group has an ongoing opportunity working in the Humanitarian Assistance Program (HAP) with SOUTHCOM, USARSO and USACE Mobile.

This feature project, a medical clinic for a remote village, is located deep in the jungles of Panama, close to the border of Colombia. The site is extremely remote. Once you leave the pavement, it is another 1/2 hour drive off-road and then a half hour ride up the river. Road access is unimproved single wide trails and will require a barge to deliver materials for construction if not constructed during the dry season.

The village is very appreciative of the US funded program and gave a great welcome at the Ribbon Cutting.
