Keesler, Wright-Patterson, and Travis Air Force Bases – Hospital Power System Analysis

HCS Group was tasked to conduct a comprehensive electrical Facility Condition Assessments and infrastructure/power distribution system assessment for three major USAF hospitals simultaneously. Included in the assessment were a complete power system analysis, a fault-current analysis, a coordination study, and an arc-flash analysis including stickers. As-built riser diagrams and floor plans were also prepared to assist in finding, repairing and testing the existing electrical system components.
